

Racing for Members - Conditions

In 2019 we added our Series Racing to the list of inclusive benefits of RSYC membership. The conditions for free race entry are:

1. Eligible boats can only be entered for a Series, or races which are part of a Series by Full Members in good standing for the duration of that Series.
2. Members may enter more than one boat, but only one is eligible for free entry in any one Series.
3. A member can enter a boat that they own, part-own or share as part of a syndicate. A part-owning or syndicate member must be on board for all entered races. A full owner must be on board for at least 50% of the entered races.
4. Boats skippered by, but not wholly or partly owned by, a member are not eligible.
5. Entry fees become liable at any point in a Series by individuals who cease to be members and by boats whose ownership ceases to include a member.
6. Unless otherwise stated, fees are payable for charity and stand-alone races.
7. A member failing to follow these conditions will receive a written warning. A further breach will render the member ineligible for further free entry.
8. Members ineligible for free entry under these conditions may appeal to the RSYC Executive Committee by emailing Sailing@rsyc.org.uk.
9. These conditions are subject to review.
